### Mayor Ed's July Notes:

Summer is here; can you feel the heat? You will soon be receiving copies of the 2 ordinances recently passed. The first is the "tax rate ordinance" where we set the tax rate for the next year. The second is the "budget ordinance" which is an overview of our fiscal '24-'25 budget. Although it doesn't make a tremendous impact on your tax bill, I am pleased to tell you that the tax rate for next year, passed by the commission, will be .283 per hundred compared to last year at .288. Keep in mind it is the county PVA that values the homes.

One thing the commission did discuss and pass that is very exciting to me was a change this year in the "early payment" credit. In the past, if you paid early you would receive a 15% discount. For the next fiscal year, if you pay your tax bill early (and most of you do), we are allowing a 20% discount in an effort to alleviate some of the increased cost due to the PVA valuation. The commission with the help of our city treasurer took a very close look at our finances and agreed that this is something we could, and should do.

Last, as your mayor and as a veteran, it is really nice to see those flags around the perimeters of some lawns. It is a nice way to say, this is our country and we are proud of it.

Have you ever considered joining the Bancroft City Commission? There will be open spots on the commission this year and we could use your talents. T
