We have now gone past the election and we will have one vacancy that will need to be filled in January. Current commissioner, Gerrie Leppert was reelected and Eric Berryhill, one of our neighbors, was elected as well. This year we had one registered "write-in" candidate and he received the votes needed to become a commissioner; and that would be resident Brad Baker.

I cannot publicly give out the police duty schedule, but I can assure you that it is not a regular "8 to 5" job. I think you will all agree with me that Chief Mudd is a great addition to our city but like you and me, he is only one person. As a reminder, let me tell you that by contract, LMPD covers our city just as they cover Metro, whenever our police are not on duty. Also, I implore you to contact him if there is an issue and do it by phone/text. I know we all like Facebook and other public forums, but he needs to be informed privately so gossip/imagination doesn't play a role in your issue.

This month I believe one of our residents had a car stolen. Make sure you are aware of your surroundings, and your property is safe. That means your empty cars need to be locked. That is strike 2 for the would be trouble makers. Nothing to steal and difficulty getting into a car frustrates them. Additionally, I will tell you that my wife watched a man park and walk a bag of trash to the end of Maria and dump it. Upon his return to his pick-up, parked by our home, he incurred the wrath of my wife and in the end, walked back, picked his trash up and drove away with it. She, on the other hand copied his license plate and passed the information on to the police. Let's all continue to be alert and continue to keep this city as one of the safest in the county.

September Meeting Minutes

FROM THE CHIEF:

Once again we've had people go through the neighborhood looking to commit larceny. I want to remind people of some simple ways to make Bancroft a less appealing target.

- 1. Make sure your garage doors are closed at night.
- 2. If cars are parked outside, make sure they are locked.

3. Remove valuables from vehicles, or at very least keep them out of sight. Never leave a weapon in your vehicle unattended.

4. Make sure you don't leave vehicle keys inside the vehicle.

5. If you see anything suspicious, or find your vehicle has been entered (even if nothing was taken) report it to law enforcement immediately.

Thanks for your help in keeping Bancroft safe.

HOW CAN WE CONTACT THE POLICE?

For immediate police assistance:

- 1. Emergency: Dial 911
- 2. Non-emergency police assistance: Dial 311

For non-urgent neighborhood concerns:

1. Call our police line at **(502) 263-3663.** Leave a voicemail with your name and phone number. Chief Mudd will call you back when he is on duty.

For your safety, please call 911 or 311 to have police dispatched. If Chief Mudd is working, then they will dispatch him to help you, otherwise, they will dispatch a Metro police officer. Do not personally seek out Chief Mudd to get assistance for an emergency.
