NOTES FROM CHIEF MUDD

FROM THE CHIEF:

With an eye towards traffic safety, I have been seeing something occur in and around Bancroft that could result in traffic collisions or perhaps even pedestrian injuries.

Drivers, when approaching a pedestrian walking against traffic while there is also a vehicle approaching from the same direction, you should treat the pedestrian as a parked car and allow the oncoming vehicle to pass before attempting to go around the pedestrian. If you do not, you risk a head-on collision with the approaching vehicle which could also result in the pedestrian being struck by one of the vehicles.

Pedestrians, if you observe this situation occurring, please step out of the road until all the vehicles have safely passed.
